GOSPEL REFLECTION: Luke 16:1-13

This parable is about being shrewd. It is commonly called the parable of the dishonest manager/steward but Jesus is focused on the shrewdness of the manager rather than his dishonesty. In Palestinian society a manager was generally a slave who was placed in charge of the household supplies and in that capacity had a fair amount of freedom with the accounts. A master would expect his manager to always show a profit and the manager would make investments, charge interest on loans and generally administer the master's assets to gain income.

In this episode the manager is caught out squandering the master's property and is facing a serious penalty. Whatever it was, it was serious enough to warrant dismissal. After all, the master doesn't want the reputation of not being able to control his servants.

It was a common bit of wisdom in antiquity that superiors were judged by the behaviour of their subordinates.

Knowing that he will get sack the manager considers his future options. He decides to work a shrewd transaction to curry favour with his master's debtors in the hope that one of them might give him a job after he is dismissed.

In Jesus' mind the morality of the manager's scheme is irrelevant. What is important is that he went all out to secure his future. In the same way we should live according to the values and teachings of Jesus to secure our ultimate future. Jesus is saying we should be equally cunning with commendable wisdom to make sure our lives fit in with His scale of values.


