

GOSPEL REFLECTION: Luke 16:19-31

This parable of the rich man and Lazarus is well known to us, although a number of the cultural issues involved here are liable to be obscure. A powerful motif running through Luke's gospel is the importance Jesus places on ministering to the poor, the rejected and the disadvantaged. And, of course, this parable is a prime example of Jesus' priorities.

The parable begins with a comparison of the situations of the rich man who lives in luxury, wears fine clothes and dines sumptuously every day, and Lazarus, covered in sores and surviving only on leftovers from the rich man's table.

There is nothing to suggest that Lazarus was a pious or holy man except that after he died he was taken by angels to the lap of Abraham, an expression signifying being welcomed, drawn close and embraced. The rich man died and was buried and ends up in Hades.

Where the rich man finished up was a place of torment. His crime seems to have been his blatant neglect of Lazarus, who represented the poor and disadvantaged. It's not as if he did anything criminally out of line, but his selfishness and lack of care was reprehensible. His plea that someone might go to his family and warn them to begin showing some concern for the disadvantaged met with Abraham's serious doubt that his brothers would change their ways. After all, they had Moses and the prophets to show them how to walk in the path of compassion. They ignore this at their own risk.

Through this parable Jesus is pointing out that in the afterlife God hands out justice – Lazarus gets to enjoy happiness with no pain and the rich man suffers for his life of unfair neglect.

PILGRIMS OF HOPE: TRANSFORMED THROUGH SACRAMENT & SONG:

Jubilee Year 2025. Pilgrims of Hope.

In front of the Holy Door of Saint Peter's Basilica in Rome, on 9 May 2024, Pope Francis delivered – Spes Non Confundit (Hope Does Not Disappoint) declaring that 2025 would be a year of Jubilee. The Holy Door was opened on 24th of December 2024, and will close on 6th of January 2026.

A year of Jubilee is a special time for remission of sins and universal pardon. It is a time of pilgrimage, reconciliation and spiritual renewal that occurs every 25 years. In special cases, the Pope may call for an extraordinary year of Jubilee. This occurred in 2016 when Pope Francis announced a Holy Year of Mercy, to highlight the Catholic Church's mission to be a witness of mercy which is "the beating heart of the Gospel".

The theme for the 2025 Jubilee year has been incorporated into the National Liturgy and Liturgical Music Conference to be held in Adelaide Hilton Hotel from 1-3 October 2025. The Australian Pastoral Musicians Network and the National Liturgical Council are delighted to invite you to our 2025 National Liturgy and Music Conference. The Conference is entitled Pilgrims of Hope: Transformed Through Sacrament & Song.
